**120 credit hours is the minimum to meet graduation requirements**

- A 2.0 minimum is required in the MAJOR and CUMULATIVE gpa to meet graduation requirements.
- The MAJOR GPA is computed using the following classes: business core, ECON 105 & 106, ITEC 100, and the required courses for this major.
- BUSINESS CORE = BLAW 203, ACTG 211 & 212, ECON 340, FINC 331, MGNT 322, MGNT 333, MGNT 357, MGNT 428, & MKTG 340.
- At least 45 hours must be taken at Radford University to be eligible for graduation, with 30 of the last 39 hours taken at RU.
- 50% of the semester hours required for this major (business core, ECON 105 & 106, & required major courses) must be taken at RU.
- **50% NON-BUSINESS POLICY** – At least 50% of the required hours for this degree must be non-business courses. ECON 105 & 106, ECON 340, STAT 200 (previous course #'s 205, 208, or 211), and MGNT 333 count as non-business courses.
