DEGREE REQUIREMENT NOTES

- 120 credit hours is the minimum to meet graduation requirements.
- A 2.0 minimum is required in the MAJOR **and** CUMULATIVE gpa to meet graduation requirements.
- **ECONOMICS CORE** = ECON 105 & 106; ECON 305 & 306; ECON 330; & ECON 495.
- **MAJOR GPA** is computed using the following classes: ECONOMICS CORE, BS Requirement courses, and the required Major courses.
- At least 45 hours must be taken at Radford University to be eligible for graduation, with 30 of the last 39 hours taken at RU; 50% of the semester hours required for this major must be taken at RU.
- **50% NON-BUSINESS POLICY** – At least 50% of the required hours for this degree must be non-business courses. ECON (105, 106 & 340) and MGNT 333 count as non-business courses. Only nine (9) hours of ECON courses can be counted as non-business.
