NOTES for all Finance Track Options

120 credit hours is the minimum number of hours needed to meet graduation requirements.

- A 2.0 minimum is required in the MAJOR and CUMULATIVE gpa to meet graduation requirements.
- MAJOR GPA is computed using the following classes: business core , ECON 105 & 106, ITEC 100 and required courses for this major.
- BUSINESS CORE : BLAW 203, ACTG 211 & 212, ECON 340, FINC 331, MGNT 322, MGNT 333, MGNT 357, MGNT 428, & MKTG 340.
- At least 45 hours must be taken at Radford University to be eligible for graduation, with 30 of the last 39 hours taken at RU.
- 50% of the semester hours required for the major must be taken at RU.
- **50% NON-BUSINESS POLICY** – At least 50% of the required hours for this degree must be in non-business courses. ECON (105, 106, & 340) and MGNT 333 count as non-business courses. Only 9 hours of ECON are allowed to count as non-business.
